

DRIVER EVALUATION & REHABILITATION



DRIVER EVALUATION INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

- Review of medical condition and status
- Driving history and license, recommendations for updating license as necessary
- Motor skills, strength, range of motion, sensa tion, coordination, balance, mobility status
- Visual abilities and perception
- Cognitive skills and knowledge of the rules of the road and proper judgment
- Route planning and traffic safety
- Adaptation, complex processing and managing situations
- Assessment for fatigue and possible decline in medical status
- Possible need for vehicle modifications and additional driver training, if needed
- Written report on recommendations

DRIVER REHABILITATION

Following a traumatic incident or the progression of certain neurological diseases, a physician may recommend that you are evaluated and go through a rehabilitation program before you resume driving. Moreover, vehicle modifications (hand controls, wheelchair lifts/ramps, etc...) may be necessary to make your vehicle drivable and safe. Driving rehabilitation will be performed on an hourly basis, after initial evaluation and assessment recommendations are given. Rehabilitation is done under the direction and supervision of the Driver Rehab Specialist. If you are in need of a vehicle modification, CHCS can recommend a vehicle modification center close to you. DRIVER EVALUATION = \$800

The driver evaluation includes a two hour off-road assessement that covers cognitive, visual and executive functions, followed by a one hour behind the wheel assessment and written summary of observations and recommendations.

HAND CONTROL ASSESSMENT = \$200 an hr.
